

Winter:

Eastlands Primary School sweatshirt or cardigan Grey long trousers, Grey skirt or pinafore dress White polo shirt (plain or with the school logo) or shirt/blouse

Black sensible school shoes or black plimsolls for indoor wear. Grey socks, White socks or grey tights School book bag/backpack with logo

In addition, for P.E. your child will need the following items which should be stored in a named bag.

Reception and Key Stage 1	White T shirt, Black shorts, Black plimsolls.
Key Stage 2	White T shirt, Black shorts, Black plimsolls or trainers with non-marking soles



Jewellery of any kind should not be worn. The only exception to this would be a watch which must be removed for PE. If ears are pierced then studs only should be worn as any other type of earing poses a serious health and safety issue.
